




#### **ABOUT THE TITLE**

#### The Helpful Healers (2011)



# The Ways of the Wise (2013)






What happened? Why did you run out like that?

No! that isnt done. We were given the opportunity and we must definitely grasp it!












Very soon they were! And it was a huge success!

For a few days the four of them learnt the correct process to help the birds and shared their ideas with Ms. Wu.


You'll have picked up the steps really fast! Seems like you want to help these birds a lot!

Ma'am I think that's because of the increased number of television wires in the sky and the fact of them not understanding if a glass is there or not is leading to these injuries.



I do.. but I get a little bored. What else can we do?


Well, my Dadisa enjoys whenever I ask her to share her stories with me, she teaches me the folk songs too! They are so experienced, why not do something around that?



A carpenter will be a pro at this work! Luckily we know one. He has come to our school also! Remember Mr. Neten?




Mr. Neten and his brother were happy to come and teach us how to make a bamboo structure.
